- Have experience with graphical user administration tools on a network.
- Have hands-on experience with computer hardware and software.
- Have installed Windows 2003/2008 Server® and service packs.
- Use the Windows Event Viewer to troubleshoot system issues.

- Define source, repository, and recovery server terminology.
- Define system and memory requirements for Double-Take Backup and continuous data protection.
- Install Double-Take Backup using both agent and repository activation codes.

- Set up and complete a point-in-time recovery job using the Double-Take Backup Console with TimeData continuous data protection.

- Apply best practices for repository server configuration.
- Locate and define logs.
- Use Double-Take Cargo to archive and retrieve data.
- Use Double-Take Move to complete a system state data migration.
